The paintings are "Citrus Pinwheels" and "Fractal Frenzy (Romanesco)'.







### Norton Simon Museum Tour – Thursday, September 25<sup>th</sup>

Please join fellow TOAA members on a private group tour of the Norton Simon Museum on Thursday, September 25<sup>th</sup>, from 10:30 a.m to approximately 4 p.m. The tour will be led by artist Lili Miura who was a docent at the museum for many years. It will last two hours, including a brief lunch break in the cafeteria. The entrance fee for the museum is \$20 for adults and \$15 for Seniors.

The Norton Simon Museum is home to one of the world's most remarkable private art collections. Over a 30-year period, industrialist Norton Simon amassed an impressive group of European masterworks from the Renaissance to the 20th century, and a stellar collection of South and Southeast Asian art spanning 2,000 years. Modern works from Europe and the United States, acquired by the former Pasadena Art Museum, also occupy an important place in the Museum's holdings.

2025 marks the fifth anniversary of the Norton Simon. The current exhibition, "Retrospect", chronicles the museum's development, collections and plans for the future.




