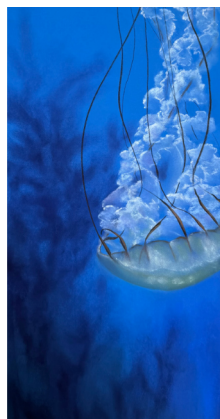

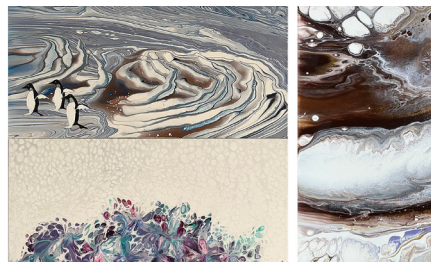

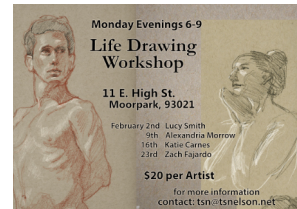

January Plein Air Outing



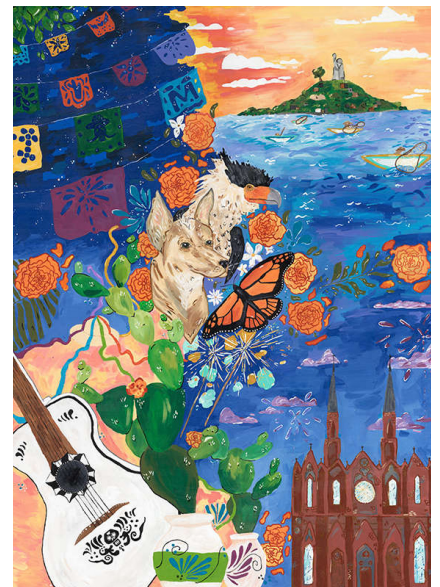
